Guidelines for Research Paper and Presentation

Guidelines for the research paper/presentation on the topics for Governance Team Initiative

You are the Superintendent working with the BOE on the targeted initiative. Either the board or the superintendent has brought the issue forward for discussion and action. The research project must present the working effort of the governance team on proposing the initiative and its implementation.

- The Problem- reason for the anticipated change or need for action
- The Purpose- Cite education law, commissioner's regulations, school district policy or state/federal regulations involved in the problem
- The Methodology- strategies for involving staff, parents, community, strategies for communicating the initiative to staff, students, parents, community
- Data collection and analysis- what data, (Data Points, Scope School Atlas, your own district's longitudinal data, NYS websites)
- Outline who will be responsible for component parts of the plan.
- Strategies for monitoring the progress/evaluation

The PowerPoint presentation should be no more than 15 slides outlining the key areas of the research. Cite references, theorists and use APA format. This is due the last Sunday of class. The paper is due 3/22/13 via email to dambrosc@stjohns.edu.
